MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA
Serdang. Selangor. Malaysia

and

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (MOA) /
UNIVERSITIES
IN
THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN

In order to develop further friendship between the peoples of our two countries, to encourage academic exchange and collaboration between UPM and MOA Universities in Jordan to advance teaching, and research in the respective institutions Universiti Putra Malaysia, Serdang, Selangor, Malaysia and the Ministry of Agriculture and various Universities in Jordan make an agreement in the fields of Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary Medicine, Human Ecology and Extension Education as follows:

1. Both parties consent to establish a cooperative relationship, through which UPM and MOA / Universities in Jordan will expedite the academic exchange of information about teaching, research and other matters.

2. Depending upon mutual agreement and the availability of funds. cooperative programs exemplified by any one or more of the following may be pursued:
 - 2.1 exchange of teaching and research personnel
 - 2.2 exchange of administrative and other professional personnel
 - 2.3 exchange of students
 - 2.4 collaboration in research projects
 - 2.5 collaboration for symposia and other academic meetings
 - 2.6 exchange of academic data and information
 - 2.7 training programs
 - 2.8 special projects of mutual benefit.

For any specific cooperative program , mutual agreement will be reached and associated documents will be signed .


3. To assist cooperative relationships between UPM and MOA and the various Universities in Jordan, each party will as far as it is reasonable provide access to research, library, computing, office and similar support facilities for visiting personnel as appropriate and as will be agreed for each cooperative program.
4. Each party will endeavour to arrange suitable accommodation for visiting personnel and students from the other university . Each party will provide advice and assistance for procedures such as application for scholarships , travel funds , visa and short - term residence requirements , and local security approvals. Each party will be responsible for ensuring travel and living expenses for its own personnel and students unless agreed otherwise for a specific cooperative program .

5. Faculties, departments, centres and other organisational units of each party are encouraged to develop and maintain appropriate contracts within the framework of the cooperative relationship between the two parties.
6. This Memorandum may be terminated by either party, giving six months notice in writing to the other party.
7. This Memorandum of Understanding, is to express the intentions of the parties. The expressed intentions are not binding, and no legally binding obligations are intended to arise as a consequence of the signing of this document. Actions taken by any party in reliance on this document will be at the party's sole risk.
